9. I'd like to see offers/discounts/sale notifications from local businesses.



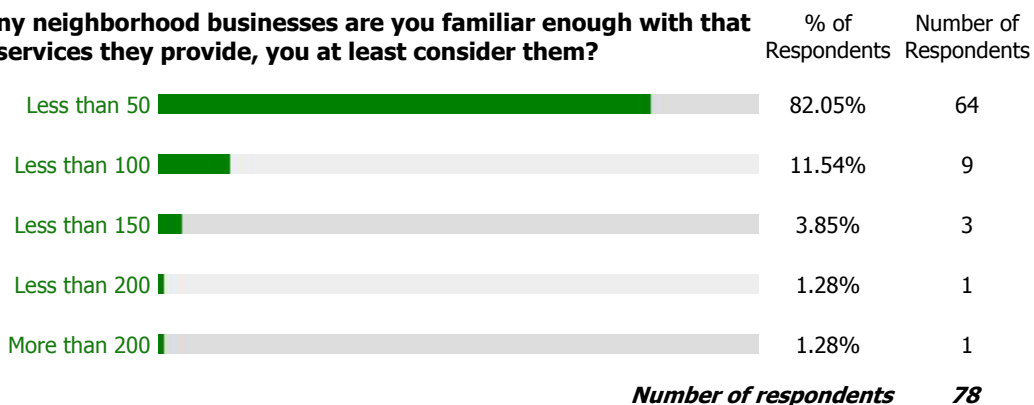
10. What would make you patronize more local businesses than you do now?

20. Excessive number of cars parked on residential streets.






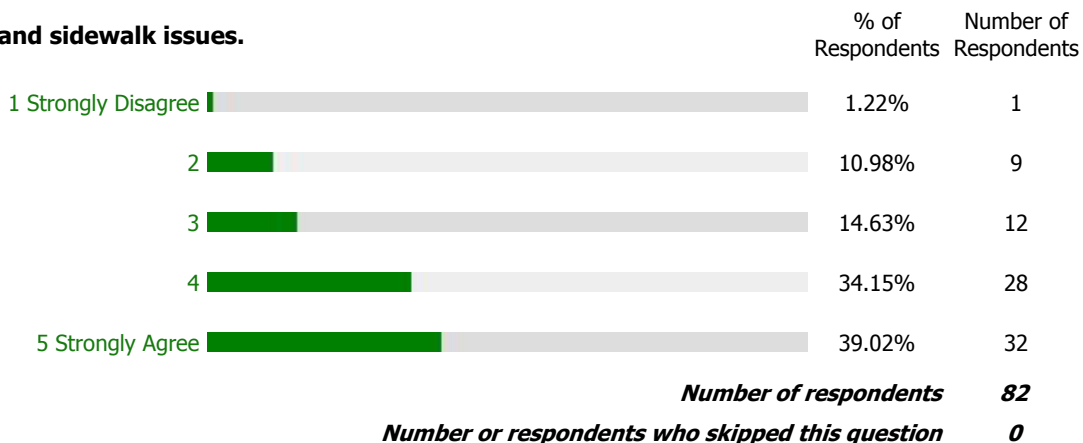
